Play

Shotgun starts are unavailable due to Covid-19. Well-spaced assigned tee times will be given for each team & golfer. Tee times will begin at 8am and continue until approximately 1pm. All tee times start at hole #1 in 7-8 minute intervals. The first group will finish their round at around 12:30pm and the last group will finish at approximately 5:00pm.

Scoring

Current U.S.G.A. standards regarding course etiquette, club and ball design, and rules of play shall be observed by all participants. The only exceptions or restrictions to these rules will be those observed by the local golf course. This is an amateur tournament. Professional golfers are welcome to play but will not be eligible for awards or prizes.

Scoring by the players will be the same as normal individual stroke play. All shots, penalties, etc. will be counted. Players may purchase a mulligan.

Mulligans

When players register online, they have the option to purchase up to two mulligans at \$5.00 each. It can be used for any golf shot during hole play. No foursome may use more than 2 mulligans in succession and there is a maximum of 2 mulligans per player for the tournament.

Food & Beverages

- ✓ There will not be a banquet/lunch after the tournament due to the wide range of assigned beginning tee times and distancing rules.
- ✓ All lunches will be a grab-and-go boxed lunch.
- ✓ You may pick up your lunch before, during or after your round of golf.
- ✓ Mt Si will have a beverage cart making the rounds around the holes. They follow strict protocol for your safety.
