How a Golf Scramble Works

Scramble tournaments are super fun events, especially as the rules are pretty lax. In general, each member of the team tees off from the designated tee marker (typically white for men and red for women). The team then chooses the best drive from all four shots. After selection of drive, all team members must hit from that position. Again, after each team member takes their shot, they choose the best shot from there. And continue this pattern until they get their ball in the hole.

The best shots will be decided upon by the team, and the score will be calculated on that basis. In most cases, the team will choose the longest shot in the fairway as their best shot. The net score is calculated based on the total scored by each team.

- ✓ All the players in a team will be asked to tee off from each hole.
- ✓ They will choose which shot is the best position and mark it and their next shot will all be shot from there.
- ✓ This procedure is continued until all the holes in the tee are covered.
- ✓ The net scores will then be calculated for the team as a whole.

1. Each team member may place his/her ball within one club length of a selected shot but not nearer to the hole. If the lie is in a hazard, trap, out-of-bounds or water, you are not allowed to use the one club length to move out of the hazard.

2. Each team member may improve his/her lie by placing by hand or by moving it with club head. The ball is in play once the player has addressed the ball.

3. When putting, the designated ball must be marked (tee marker) no nearer to the hole. Once a ball is holed out, no further strokes are permitted.

4. No drive minimums.

Other Contest Rules

Mulligans may not be used for Hole-In-One holes, prize holes (Line Drive, Longest Drive, or Closest to Pin)

Longest Drive Must be in the fairway (no rough).
Marker is placed on the furthest drive.
Mulligan may not be used.

Line Drive

Player's lie is closest to the line regardless of distance.

If two players have lies the same distance from the line, marker should be placed on the furthest from the tee.

Mulligan may not be used.

Hole-in-One(s)

All players get one (1) shot only.

Mulligan may not be used.

Closest to Pin

Mulligan may not be used.
