The Visitors Information Center

The Visitors Information Center (VIC) has all the information and maps you'll need to make your visit to Issaquah fun and memorable! Located along with the Greater Issaquah Chamber of Commerce in the historic Alexander House at 155 NW Gilman Blvd. www.issaquahchamber.com



Historic Downtown Issaquah

Take a walking tour of the original city center along Front and Sunset Street and discover a vibrant commercial core dotted with historical landmarks and public art. www.downtownissaquah.com

Gilman Town Hall Museum & Jail

Originally built in 1888, the building was purchased by the Town of Gilman and converted to the Town Hall. Next door is the old city jail built in 1914. Located at SE Andrews St. www.issaquahhistory.org/museums

Train Depot Museum

Completed in 1889, the Depot originally belonged to the Seattle, Lake Shore and Eastern Railway. It was closed in 1958 and today houses a museum. Located at 50 Rainier Blvd North. www.issaquahhistory.org/museums/issaquah-depot

Issaquah Valley Trolley

The historical trolley offers round trip rides from the Depot Museum to Gilman Boulevard between May - September. www.issaquahhistory.org/museums

Gilman Village

Composed of buildings preserved from the original farming and mining communities of Issaquah, Gilman Village offers over 40 shops and restaurants. Located at 317 NW Gilman Blvd. www.gilmanvillage.com

Pickering Barn

Purchased in 1867 by Washington Territorial Governor William Pickering, the barn has been placed on the National Register of Historic Places and hosts the annual Issaquah Farmers Market. Located at 1730 10th Ave. NW. 3321. www.issaquahhistory.org/buildings-sites/pickering-barn

Salmon Hatchery

Constructed in 1936 by the Federal Works Progress Administration, the Issaquah Salmon Hatchery is the most visited fish hatchery in the state of Washington. Located at 125 W Sunset Way. www.issaquahfish.org
